

**Del Loewenthal** is Professor of Psychotherapy and Counselling, and Director of the Research Centre for Therapeutic Education at the University of Roehampton, where he also convenes Doctoral programmes. He is an existential-analytic psychotherapist, chartered psychologist and photographer. He is founding editor of the European Journal of Psychotherapy and Counselling (Routledge). He chairs the Universities Counselling and Psychotherapy Association and is former founding chair of the UK Council for Psychotherapy Research Committee.
